

# **BOLD FAITH**

CRAFT | LESSON 3

## IZZI'S MEGAPHONE

The kids will make this craft to help them practice using their voice to speak up for what is right, remembering the example from the Bible story about Esther.

### DIRECTIONS

#### **PRFP**

- 1. Print out Izzi's Megaphone printable on 11x17" card stock. (1 per child)
- 2. Cut out the megaphone.
- 3. Use a hole and punch 2 holes at the top where indicated.
- 4. Cut 30-inch pieces of yarn or ribbon (1 per child).
- 5. Gather Izzi's Megaphone printables, stickers (optional), yarn or ribbon pieces, tape, and crayons or markers for the leaders.

#### MAKE

- 1. Pass out the Izzi's Megaphone printables (1 per child) and coloring and decorating supplies for the kids to share.
- 2. As the kids begin coloring, read the Big Idea out loud. Say, our Big Idea says I can have bold faith when I speak up for what is right!
- 3. Ask: What is something that will help us speak up for what is right? (Pause for kids to identify their megaphones.)
- 4. Megaphones are special tools to help make our voices nice and loud. We can use our voices to ask for help, tell the truth, and tell others about Jesus!
- 5. When the kids are done coloring, help them wrap their megaphone and tape it together.
- 6. Thread and tie the yarn or ribbon through the holes at the top of the megaphone, making a lanyard for the kids to wear their megaphones.
- 7. While the kids color and create, discuss the Talking Points.
