This month your toddler is learning about The Parable of the Lost Sheep and that God loves them! Take some time to be encouraged as you think through how to talk about the Bible story at home with your child.

We all know the joy of finding something that we thought was lost. But have you considered that God experiences joy when a person who was “lost” returns to him, too? Consider any areas in your life that you feel “lost.” In what ways could you be drawing closer to him?

The Parable of the Lost Sheep reminds us that God is a loving shepherd who is not willing for a single one of his children to stay lost! And when he finds us, he celebrates with great joy and showers us with his love!

Here are some practical ways to connect what your kids are hearing and learning about at church to their daily lives:

- **Take a look at some pictures of friends and family and ask your child, “Who does God love in this picture?” Emphasize that God loves everyone!**



- **Play a version of I-Spy together on your next walk or drive. Express great joy and excitement when an item is found and remind your child that the shepherd found the lost sheep!**



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
