TODDLER CRAFT | LESSON 3

FIVE STONES

In this craft, the children will create their own scene from the Bible story. They will glue five stones to represent the five smooth stones David collected from the stream to fight the giant, Goliath. This will help remind the kids that David was brave because he knew God was the biggest and strongest.

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

- 1. Print out the Fives Stones printable on cardstock and the Stones printable.
- 2. Cut out the "stones" so you have five stones per child.
- 3. Have printables, stones, crayons, and glue ready for the leaders.

DURING THE SERVICE

- 1. Pass out the Five Stones printable for the kids to begin coloring.
- 2. Give each child five stones to glue onto their scene. Count the stones with them.
- 3. Read the excerpt of the poem from Stories of the Bible Jr.
- 4. While the kids make their craft, discuss the talking points:
 - Point to Goliath. Who is this?
 - Is Goliath mean or nice? He was mean.
 Show me a mean face.
 - Point to David. Who is this?
 - Was David afraid of Goliath? No. He was brave. He loved God and God loved him.
 - Who else does God love? Say God loves you to each child.
